Marie Cinti introduced the **Program**: Community Supported Agriculture(CSA) at Wickham Farms, Rt. 250, Penfield.

Speaker Bill Wickham, Wickham Farms

Bill brought fresh veggies and donuts to the meeting to share. Marie passed out donuts.

Bill briefly explained his background, growing up on a farm, going to Cornell University, began by selling pumpkins. Bought Wickham Farms in 2001, constructed the building in 2005. The Farm is now open April-October 31.

This year was the first year for the CSA program, a 20 week harvest share membership program. He bought the 100 acre Willmis/Casa Larga property across the street from the Farm in March. He took 65 acres of the vineyard out. Planted a variety of 60 types of vegetables, one fruit: melons along with remaining grapes. He will plant garlic next year. Planted under black plastic mulch. First pick up with recipes for CSA members was on June 15.

The Farm used drip irrigation. With 8 acres of vegetables the Water bill was still \$2,800!

When taking down the vineyards, posts, wires, they ended up with 4 and 1/2 tons of wire, 20,000 posts that were taken to Alco to be recycled.

Several dozens of vineyards were kept-Niagara grapes.

Bill spoke of families picking at the farm-leads to healthy eating habits for the young.
